



BELONDRADE QUINTA CLARISA 2019

Varieties: Tempranillo and others

IGP: V. T. Castila y León

Alc.: 13% Vol.

Viticulture et vinification:

Wine produced from the only grape vines of the Quinta san Diego estate. This plot is located on a gentle slope mde up of sandy soils a few metres from the winery, the whole plto si harvested in one go followed by careful sorting in the cellar and a 24-hour-run juice is kept, which is fermented spontaneously.

Climate conditions: A rainy autumn was the antechamber of a winter and a spring that registered slightly higher temperatures than those of 2018, with especially low rainfall. Summer brought the long-awaited rains that dropped, from July to September, about half of the water of the entire agricultural year. The low yields due to the lack of water during budding were compensated by an unusual freshness and acidity in the musts thanks to the summer rains. These conditions have resulted in particularly elegant wines, with tension and a marked character.

BELONDRADE QUINTA CLARISA is the re-interpretation of "rosé wine" according to BELONDRADE. A wine with red wine's structure and rosé wine's freshness.
