Tasting analysis:

This wine has an intense cherry color, with purple edges, well covered.

On the nose it is very powerful and complex, with notes of wild fruits and red berries, with slightly toasted tips and a slight mineral hint.

In the mouth it is very balanced with a soft and fruity attack well integrated, easy and pleasant to drink.
