Viñedos de San Vicente

REPELLURI

Wine made with the grapes of the family's traditional suppliers in San Vicente. This is a selection of 36 vineyard plots occupying a total of 13.95 ha, worked by 11 winegrowers and expressing a variety of soils, winds and orientations ranging from the gritty terrains of the quaternary period alongside the Ebro at 425 metres asl, to the poorer, more rocky soils, constituted by sandstone and loam of tertiary origin rising to as high as 695 metres.

Tasting notes:

San Vicente always offers a marked, defined character typical of the villages of the Sonsierra region. Black fruits, blackberries and spiced notes. The voluptuous landscape of these hillsides always offer us wines with a broader and silkier texture which envelops a defined, fresh structure in perfect balance.

Vintage 2015:

A long winter with heavy snowfall followed by a rainy spring left an important water reserve in the soil. Very warm and dry weather in the first half of the summer considerably advanced the vegetative cycle, further accelerated by occasional rains at the end of veraison. This resulted in the earliest harvest that is remembered in Rioja. In our case it was also a very long harvest. Atypical and promising vintage, with good ripening, very good health and a marked fruity aromatic potential.

Ageing Potential:

We offer this wine matured in bottle for more than 2 years, making it perfectly suitable for immediate consumption.

Given the quality of the vineyard and the structure of the year, we believe that this wine will evolve nicely over the next 10-12 years.
