• **OTHER DATA:** *The Godello variety (according to experts say it originates from the slopes of the Rio Sil) presents a very complex and diverse aromatic profile, where the rustic aromas, laden with minerality, citrus and balsamic notes and a light fragrance floral. In the mouth they have a powerful and intense presence, glyceric, with intense and fresh acidity, balanced and well structured wines. It is an early variety that adapts very well to dry soils and does not favor moist soils. It has an immense potential and very good capacity of aging in oak when optimal conditions of maturation are given.*

• **TASTING NOTES:** *Clear and bright, straw yellow with green sparkles. Of medium intensity, aromas of herbal frescoes (boxwood, junco, elderberry, grass) and fruits (claudia, acerola, pear). Pure harmony and balance, it fills the mouth with flavor and aroma, it invades everything. (Galicia Wines Guide)*
